Dear Anderson Families,

The Anderson Library Media Center strives to include a wide variety of high quality books to suit students' interests and educational needs. As such, the library contains a collection of "Young Adult" (YA) books. The YA section contains books that are aimed at teen readers. These books usually feature teenage protagonists and contain themes that reflect the struggles of coming of age. Most are told from the teenage viewpoint. Some contain mature subject matter such as strong language, graphic descriptions, and sexual content. Some examples of books in the YA section include *American Born Chinese* by Yang, *Monster* by Myers, and the *Twilight* series by Meyer. Students in grades fifth through eight may use and borrow these materials if their families give them permission.

Of course, Young Adult books are not the only books in the library about sensitive topics or with mature themes. Please have a conversation with your child if there are particular subjects or areas that you would prefer them not to access, or to let them know that you will be reviewing the books they take home.

Attached is the Young Adult Literature Access Permission Slip for the 2018-2019 school year. Please sign and return this permission slip to let us know if your fifth through eighth grade child is authorized to access and borrow from the YA collection. Each year the permission slip will be sent home again for renewal.
