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Anderson Dress Code

The student dress code was created by the SLT and adopted in 2011. Inappropriate attire interferes with teaching and learning.

- The following items are prohibited:
 - o tube or halter tops
 - o tank tops (except for grades K-2)
 - o net tops
 - o spaghetti straps
 - o plunging necklines that reveal any cleavage or dip too low in the back
 - o clothing that exposes the mid-section of the body
 - o stockings/tights with inappropriate designs (*e.g.* fishnets, lace, seamed back, ripped or torn)
 - o hats/hoods worn indoors
- The following items must adhere to prescribed requirements:
 - o Skirts, dresses and shorts MUST be no more than 4 inches above the knee
 - Undergarments, including bra/bra straps, boxers, briefs, and thongs, must be completely covered by outer garments
 - o Pants must be seated at the waist; we recommend wearing a belt for oversized clothing
 - o Leggings must be opaque and may not be worn as stand-alone pants
- Additional dress code guidelines:
 - Footwear must be worn at all times. Sneakers must be worn on Physical Education days. Although not prohibited, we strongly recommend not wearing flip flops or backless shoes due to safety concerns.
 - O Clothing may not be vulgar, obscene, libelous, or denigrate others on account of race, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, or disability.
 - Clothing may not promote or endorse the use of alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, and/or encourage other illegal or violent activities.
- Consequences for violating the dress code:
 - o 1st offense: The school will provide replacement clothing for the student.
 - o <u>2nd offense</u>: A parent/guardian will be notified that he/she needs to bring a change of clothing to school immediately. The student will be removed from class until the clothing arrives.
 - o <u>3rd offense</u>: Students in grades 6-8 will lose one week of off-campus lunch. Students in grades K-5 will lose one recess period or free choice period
 - 4th offense: Student will receive one day of in-school suspension.
